



## Academy Rules & Regulations

These rules and regulations (the Academy Rules & Regulations) form a binding agreement between each child and the Academy.

### Rules and Regulations

- (a) The Academy will abide by The FA's Child Protection Policies and Procedures, Codes of Conduct and the Equal Opportunities and Anti-Discrimination Policy.
- (b) Each child attending the sessions at the Academy is requested to wear their Soccer Excel Football Academy t-shirt
- (c) Each child attending the sessions will need to wear appropriate footwear and shin pads. It is recommended that children also bring a still drink.
- (d) No football boots or trainers, that are likely to cause damage to the astro surface, are to be worn. This includes boots with metal studs and blades.
- (e) Should any child or parent/carer wish to cancel their membership, no-refund will be issued unless accompanied by a Doctor's note.
- (f) Soccer Excel Ltd reserves the right to exclude any child from the sessions and The Academy permanently due to repetitive inappropriate behaviour. Prior to any exclusion, the child and parent/carer will be issued with verbal and written warnings in an attempt to resolve the matter before any final action is taken.
- (g) If a child is excluded for any of the above reasons, no refund will be issued to the excluded individual or parents/carers.
- (h) Entry to the astro pitch must be across the grass cricket outfield (avoiding the cricket squares).
- (i) Players must either clean their trainers or change into clean trainers before going onto the astro pitch.
- (j) Soccer Excel recommends that children use the Clubhouse toilets before the session starts. Please note there are no toilets by the astro pitch and there will be no stoppages for toilet needs.
- (k) Players must respect the pitch.
- (l) All rubbish must be placed into the bins provided.
- (m) All cars must be parked in the car park.
- (n) There must be no unruly behaviour by players or spectators.
